Station Terrace Level Crossing, Peterston-Super-Ely

We are getting in touch with you about Station Terrace level crossing in Peterston-Super-Ely and to invite you to our upcoming community meeting to discuss the matter further.

We took the difficult decision to temporarily close the crossing back in October 2025 following evidence of significant safety concerns. Our monitoring camera showed around 85 % of users were not crossing correctly and safely despite clear signage and instructions.

The crossing traverses two lines on the South Wales Main Line with a maximum line speed of 75mph with over 236 train movements per day. This is why we had a telephone next to the crossing so that users could call the signaller to obtain permission to cross safely. There are no active, visual or audible warning systems at this location.

Our teams have been looking into the different options available and how feasible those are including whistle boards, diversion of footpath, miniature stop light and footbridges.

Therefore, we would like to invite you to our community meeting on **Monday 10th August at Peterston's Village Hall between 7pm and 9pm** to discuss the options further.

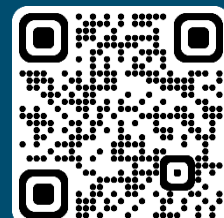

Rydym yn cysylltu â chi ynghylch croesfan wastad Teras yr Orsaf yn Llanbedr-y-fro, i'ch gwahodd i'r cyfarfod cymunedol sydd gennym ar y gweill i drafod y pwnc ymhellach.

Mae'r groesfan yn croesi dwy linell ar Brif Linell De Cymru, sydd â therfyn cyflymder o 75mya a lle mae mwy na 236 o drenau'n mynd heibio bob dydd. O'r herwydd, roedd gennym deleffon yn ymyl y groesfan, er mwyn i ddefnyddwyr ffonio'r signalwr i ofyn am ganiatâd i groesi'n ddiogel. Nid oes unrhyw systemau rhybudd gwledol na chlywedol yn weithredol yn y lleoliad hwn.

Mae ein timau wedi bod yn edrych ar yr opsiynau gwahanol sydd ar gael a'u dichonoldeb, gan gynnwys byrddau chwiban, dargyfeirio'r llwybr troed, goleuadau stopio bach, a phontydd troed.
